

# Traditional Colombian Yage for screened cohorts

A 7-day / 6-night program for veterans, first responders, and partner organizations seeking preparation, ceremony, integration, and community support near Medellin.

## DURATION

7 days / 6 nights

## CEREMONY

3 traditional Yage ceremonies

## GROUP SIZE

6-8 recommended, 12 maximum

## COST

\$1,100 USD per participant

## WHAT'S INCLUDED

- 6 nights accommodation and all meals
- Airport transfers from Medellin
- 3 traditional Colombian Yage ceremonies
- Medical screening and physician review
- Daily integration circles and group workshops
- Sound healing with Camilo Campo
- Nature immersion and small cohort support
- 30-day, 60-day, and 90-day follow-up integration

## 7-DAY STRUCTURE

Arrival and decompression; preparation and first ceremony; integration and rest; second ceremony; community and reconnection; final ceremony; departure planning and follow-up bridge.

## SAFETY AND SCREENING

Not everyone should drink Yage. Screening includes application, medical form, medication review, psychological history, physician review, and a video call when needed. Some applicants may be deferred or declined.

- Active crisis, psychosis history, bipolar I, unstable cardiovascular concerns, contraindicated medications, severe withdrawal, or inability to prepare may lead to deferral.
- Do not stop or change medication without a qualified medical professional.

## PARTNER MODEL

- Sponsor one participant
- Sponsor a closed cohort of 6-8 participants
- Refer and collaborate with anonymized cohort-level reporting

## PROGRAM BOUNDARIES

**This program is not medical treatment, therapy, a PTSD cure, a replacement for psychiatric care, a crisis intervention program, recreational psychedelic tourism, or a guaranteed transformation program.**
